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PATHWAY OF FLAGS CONTRACT

Date: _____

This contract (agreement) is to grant a site on the Pathway of Flags, inside Maple Grove Cemetery, in Mason, MI. The agreement is between Browne/Cavender, American Legion Post #148 (herein referred to as the seller) and buyer.

I, _____ agree to purchase and 8"X12" granite stone, flagpole, and a 3'X5' American flag from the seller for the price of five hundred dollars (\$500). The site will be set in accordance with the seller's plan to follow certain paved paths or roads with in the aforementioned cemetery. No site is guaranteed without the seller's consent.

The seller will construct each site in accordance with the guidelines of the Mason Maple Grove Cemetery Board. Said sites will consist of a 8"x12" granite stone having a maximum of four (4) lines, encased in cement at ground level, so as not to hinder Maple Grove maintenance. Each site will have a flagpole approximately fifteen (15) feet in height, with a single 3'X5' American flag. The height of said flagpole and distance between sites will depend on location and terrain. This placement will be at the discretion of the seller.

The granite stone is permanent. The flagpole and flag, depending on the weather, is displayed from April/May ot October/November of each year. The flagpole and flag are stored the remainder of the year.

Maintenance and care of each site is the seller's responsibility. Dissolution of American Legion Browne/Cavender Post #148 will cancel the maintenance of this contract.
